GENERAL SERVICE SMALL

AVAILABILITY:

Entire Service Territory

APPLICABILITY:

This rate is applicable to all farm, commercial and municipal water pumping consumers, subject to the Cooperative's Rules and Regulations.

TYPE OF SERVICE:

Single or three-phase, 60 cycles, alternating current at available voltages.

RATE:

Customer Charge: \$25.00 per month
Energy Charge: \$0.10189 per kWh


MINIMUM:

The minimum monthly bill shall be the highest of the following charges:

1. Customer charge;
2. Where it is necessary to make extensions or to reinforce distribution lines to provide service such that, in the judgment of Cooperative, the revenue to be derived from, or the duration of the prospective business is not sufficient under the above-stated minimum to warrant the investment, Cooperative may require an adequate minimum monthly bill based upon reasonable consideration before undertaking to supply service. In any event, Consumer shall be required to sign an agreement for Electric Service as to character, minimum monthly bill, and duration of the business offered.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE:

1. Motors having a rated capacity in excess of ten horsepower (10 hp) must be three-phase unless they are of a type approved by Cooperative;
2. Service under this schedule is limited to loads not in excess of 25 kW. If the demand exceeds 25 kW for two (2) consecutive months, the applicable schedule may be applied for a period of not less than one (1) year unless Consumer's load changes, thereby requiring reclassification to another schedule;
3. Consumers having their homes on the same premises with their business establishment may include both the home and the business on the same meter and be billed under this schedule; or, if the Consumer prefers, he may make provisions for two meters, in which case his home will be billed on the applicable residential schedule and his usage for other purposes will be billed under this schedule; and
4. If it is necessary to make extensions or to reinforce distribution lines to provide service, the customer charge will be determined in accordance with the Line Extension Policy as set forth in the Rules and Regulations.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

In accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Cooperative as they currently exist or may be amended from time to time.

ENERGY COST ADJUSTMENT:


The above energy charge shall be increased or decreased in accordance with Schedule ECA, as it currently exists or may be amended from time to time.
